A & B Pro Guides Gift certificates are valid for up to two years from date of issue and will be credited toward any trip chosen, up to \$150.00 maximum, or a predetermined limit set by the purchaser. The full price of your gift certificate deposit is 100 percent refundable if canceled within the first 6 months of issue.

When the recipient of the gift certificate decides on the date and species he or she would like to fish they simply call our office, preferably a minimum of three days in advance. At which time we will check current fishing conditions and arrange their trip with the best possible guide, nearest to their location, that can insure the highest chance of success for the type of fishing they would like to do.

When dates are confirmed and seats reserved, the balance for the total price of the trip would be due from the purchaser of the gift certificate. The purchaser would be notified when the trip is booked, prior to any charges. Most guided trips range from \$150.00 to \$165.00 per person for a full day of fishing. Ocean charters are slightly less, \$85.00 to \$135.00 per person depending on the location and type of trip chosen.

Note: Specialty trips including tuna, halibut, fly fishing, pack trips and overnight trips that exceed the \$150.00 limit would need to be approved by the purchaser.
