

Horse Back and Hike in Fishing and Hunting Trips




Leavenworth, WA

We offer pack trips and day rides in the Leavenworth, Lake Wenatchee, and Entiat Ranger Districts. Some of our trips will enter into the unspoiled country of the Alpine Lakes, Glacier Peak and Henry M. Jackson Wilderness Areas in the Wenatchee and the Mt. Baker/Snoqualmie National Forests.

We have a pack station in the Entiat Valley as well as two trail ride stables. One stable is located at Lake Wenatchee State Park and the other is 2.5 miles from the town of Leavenworth, in the Icicle Valley.

Our winter sleigh rides are also located in the Icicle Valley. During the winter months, the Leavenworth area becomes a winter wonderland with many activities available.

The high-mountain lakes and streams offer fishing that will appeal to the novice as well as the experienced angler. The fishing is surpassed only by the beauty of the country itself.

Fall Hunting Trips

Deer, Elk & Bear Deluxe Hunting Trips: We provide saddle horses, pack horses, guide, wrangler, cook, food, tent, and the camp. Bring your own weapons and tags, sleeping bag and personal gear... we provide the rest! These hunts are 5 - 7 days in length and are semi guided.

Guided one-on-one hunts: (Available 1 to 7 day hunts)

Deer, Elk and Bear Drop Camps: We provide the saddle horses, pack horses, and the packer. We pack your group and gear into a campsite and pick you up at a pre-determined time. Drop camps can range from 3 to 10 days in length, your choice, same price.

\$650/person

Hike in Drop Camps: This trip is the same as the Drop Camp, except you hike (or ride your own horse). This may be the most economical trip for your group.

\$500/person

Wall Tent and Wood Stove Rental: \$100/camp. Our wall tents are 14x16 ft., they're great for bad weather. *(All prices subject to change).*

Hunting Areas: Clark 244; Chiwawa 245; Slide Ridge 246; Entiat 247; Alpine 249; Swakane 250; Mission 251 All of these areas are located on the east side of the Cascade Mountains, in the heart of North Central Washington, approximately a 2 hour drive from Seattle and a 3 hour drive from Spokane. **For more information call 503-720-9033**


Custom Deluxe Pack Trips: We provide saddle horses, pack horses, wrangler, cook, food, tent, and the camp. We customize the trip to your specifications on the length of your stay and destination. Trips may range from two to seven days. Bring your sleeping bag and personal gear -- we will bring the rest!

Drop Camps: We provide saddle horses, pack horses and the packer. We pack your group and gear into a campsite and pick you up at a pre-determined time.

Lake Wenatchee State Park Riding Stable



2 Mile Ride:

Eight guided rides daily, leaving on the hour (9 a.m. to 11 a.m. and 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.) from out stables at Lake Wenatchee State Park. The ride is about 45 to 50 minutes long, it is suitable for all ages and abilities. Riders must be at least 6 years old to ride their own horse, younger children may ride with an adult for 1/2 price. Advance reservations advised. Drop-in guests are welcome

\$18.51/person

4 Mile Ride:

Two guided rides daily, leaving at 9 a.m. and at 3 p.m. The ride is about one hour and 45 minutes long. This ride is suitable for riders 6 years old and older. No double riding. Reservations required.

\$37.02/person

Day Ride:

The ride is approximately 13 miles long and takes about 5-6 hours. Lunch is included. Leaves Lake Wenatchee State Park at 9:00-10:00 a.m.. 24 hours or longer reservations required.

\$120.00/person

Our Lake Wenatchee stables are located on the south shore of Lake Wenatchee at the State Park. Only 3 miles from Highway 2. The stable is open from mid-May to late-September.

Leavenworth / Icicle River Riding Stable



Our Leavenworth stables are located on the Icicle Road, just past the National Fish Hatchery, next to the Sleeping Lady Retreat Center. Less than 3 miles from Highway 2 and the town of Leavenworth. The stables are open from mid May to late September.

2 Mile Ride:

Open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily, for guided rides from our Icicle River Riding Stables. The ride is 40 to 50 minutes long. It is suitable for all ages and abilities. Riders must be at least 6 years old to ride their own horse. Younger riders may ride with an adult for 1/2 price. Drop-in guests welcome. Reservations available.

4 Mile Ride:

Available daily. The ride is about 1 hour and 30 minutes long. This ride is suitable for riders 6 years and older. Drop ins welcome.
